- Precept 2-3 new grad RNs per cohort; built a pocket reference for weight-based med dosing that the educator adopted unit-wide.
- Step in as relief charge nurse on weekend nights, running staffing assignments for up to 28 patients and triaging admits from the ED.
- Lead family teaching for new asthma, T1D, and post-op tonsillectomy discharges; 30-day readmits trending below department target.
