- Rotated through med-surg, ICU step-down, postpartum, and pediatric oncology, completing 540 supervised clinical hours under preceptor sign-off.
- Carried a 3-patient assignment on the cardiac telemetry floor during senior practicum, charting assessments, I&Os, and medication administration in Epic.
- Educated 12 newly diagnosed Type 2 diabetic patients on insulin self-administration and carb counting; preceptor noted improved teach-back accuracy at discharge.
- Caught a charting discrepancy on a heparin drip during shift handoff and escalated to the RN, preventing a potential dosing error.
- Recognized as Student of the Rotation on the postpartum unit for breastfeeding support and patient rapport.

#### Patient Care Technician (Per Diem)

- Support a 32-bed orthopedic unit with vitals, ambulation, hygiene care, and blood glucose checks for up to 10 patients per shift.

- Assist RNs with post-op transfers, drain emptying, and Foley catheter care while maintaining sterile technique.
- Trained 4 new PCTs on safe patient handling and Hoyer lift use during summer onboarding.

- Led monthly hypertension screenings for underinsured adults, taking manual BPs and referring 18 patients to follow-up care.
