Correctional Officer II | Cypress Ridge Correctional Facility, Tallahassee, FL | 2020 – Present

- Supervise housing unit of 184 inmates across 12-hour shifts, conducting headcounts, cell inspections, and security rounds at random intervals per post orders.
- Logged 47 contraband recoveries in 2023 (cell phones, makeshift weapons, suboxone strips), the highest on B-shift and double the unit average.
- Serve as Field Training Officer for new correctional officers, taking 6-8 trainees per year through the 90-day on-floor checklist.
- De-escalated a cell extraction standoff without use of force after roughly 40 minutes of verbal negotiation, documented as a model response in shift briefing.
- Cross-trained on Special Housing Unit, sally port control, and transport, picking up overtime posts when staffing falls short.

- Worked general population housing, dining hall, and rec yard rotations, completing required searches and inmate accountability checks each shift.
- Wrote disciplinary reports and use-of-force statements that held up under shift commander and IA review, with no reports kicked back for rewrite in 2019.
- Responded to medical emergencies as first on scene, including 3 overdose reversals using naloxone before EMS arrival.
- Pulled regular K-9 assist posts during shakedowns of high-risk dorms.
