Student Teacher, 4th Grade | Pinewood Heights Elementary School, Providence, RI
Jan 2024 – Present

- Took over full instructional load in week 6, planning and teaching all five subject areas to a class of 24 students for the remainder of the placement.
- Designed a 3-week fractions unit aligned to CCSS 4.NF; 19 of 24 students scored proficient or higher on the end-of-unit assessment, up from 11 on the pre-test.
- Adapted guided reading groups for 6 students with IEPs in partnership with the resource teacher, using leveled texts and graphic organizers.
- Introduced a morning check-in routine that cut transition time between activities and reduced off-task referrals during literacy block.
- Logged weekly reflections and lesson revisions in a mentor-reviewed journal as part of program requirements.

Practicum Student, 2nd Grade | Brookline Avenue School, Providence, RI
Sep 2023 – December 2023

- Co-taught small-group phonics interventions twice weekly for 8 emerging readers using Heggerty and decodable texts.
- Built a classroom library checkout system that doubled weekly student book check-outs over a 6-week stretch.
- Led morning meeting and SEL circle time on Fridays, planning prompts tied to the school's Responsive Classroom framework.
- Observed and coded 20 hours of veteran teacher instruction using the Danielson Framework as part of coursework.
