LEAD PRE-K TEACHER AND CURRICULUM COACH | SAGUARO SPRINGS EARLY LEARNING CENTER, MESA, AZ 2019 – PRESENT

- Lead a Pre-K classroom of 22 children while coaching 6 teachers across the center on curriculum and classroom management.
- Built a center-wide curriculum binder aligned to the Arizona Early Learning Standards now used in all 5 classrooms.
- Increased family re-enrollment from 72% to 91% over three years by adding monthly family events and individual learning portfolios.
- Led prep for Quality First rating reviews; center moved from 3 stars to 5 stars in 2022.
- Cover assistant director duties one day per week, including ratio scheduling and parent intake tours.
