- Responded to roughly 1,450 calls per year on Engine 22, with structure fires, MVAs, and ALS medical transports making up the bulk of run volume.
- Promoted to nozzle position after 14 months; pulled attack lines on 38 working structure fires without a crew injury or RIT activation.
- Trained 6 probationary firefighters on hose deployment, ladder throws, and SCBA confidence drills as a Field Training Officer.
- Rebuilt the station's vehicle extrication tool inventory after an audit flagged expired hydraulic lines, saving the district from a citation.
