2021 - PRESENT

- Carry a 1:1 to 1:2 active-labor assignment averaging 14 deliveries per shift across the unit, including preterm labor, preeclampsia, and TOLAC patients.
- Serve as primary circulator for roughly 220 scheduled and emergent cesareans annually; consistently meet decision-to-incision under 22 minutes on STAT calls.
- Co-led the unit's hemorrhage QI project that reduced postpartum transfusion rates from 4.1% to 2.3% over 18 months through earlier QBL and bundle compliance.
- Precept new grads and travel RNs through a 10-week orientation; 9 of 11 preceptees stayed past their first year.
- Pilot user for new Philips Avalon fetal monitoring strips integration into Epic Stork; wrote the unit cheat sheet still in use today.

- Rotated between triage, labor, c-section recovery, and antepartum on a 22-bed unit delivering around 1,800 babies a year.

- Pulled into the rapid response role for 3 shoulder dystocias and 2 cord prolapses during my last year; all neonates discharged home with mom.
