2021 – Present

- Frame walls, floors, and roofs on 3 to 5 story wood-frame apartment buildings averaging 84 units per project
- Pull permits and walk inspectors through rough-in stages, passing first inspection on 9 of the last 11 phases
- Run a 4-person crew on layout and framing, hitting weekly production targets without overtime
- Train two apprentices on tool safety, plan reading, and square/level/plumb checks before sheathing

- Poured and finished roughly 1,800 cubic yards of concrete for foundations, slabs, and sidewalks
- Set forms, tied rebar, and operated power buggies, screeds, and walk-behind trowels

- Flagged a misread footing depth on the site plan that would have failed inspection
- Kept tools and PPE inventoried for a crew of 12, cutting replacement orders by about a third
