PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

Inventory Manager | Brightline Industrial Supply, Raleigh, NC | 2021 – Present

- Own inventory accuracy across 3 DCs holding roughly 14,000 SKUs; raised cycle count accuracy from 88% to 97.4% over six quarters by rebuilding the count cadence and retraining team leads.
- Cut excess and obsolete stock by \$1.86M in the first year by introducing a 30/60/90 aging review tied to a markdown matrix purchasing now uses every Monday.
- Rolled out demand planning in NetSuite for our top 400 SKUs; reduced stockouts on A-items by about a third without increasing average on-hand value.
- Manage a team of 6 (2 analysts, 4 cycle counters). Built a cross-training plan so any counter can run any zone.
- Partner weekly with purchasing, ops, and finance on a reconciliation review; closed the historical variance gap that used to surface at year-end audit.

Inventory Control Supervisor | Cardinal Outdoor Goods, Greensboro, NC | 2018 – 2021

- Supervised cycle counting and reconciliation for a 220,000 sq ft DC supporting 90 retail stores.
- Identified a recurring receiving error that had been writing off about \$42K per quarter; fix paid back in the first month.
- Built the company's first ABC analysis in Excel and Power Query, which became the basis for the new count frequency rules.
- Coached 4 cycle counters and 2 receivers; two of the four were promoted within 18 months.

Inventory Analyst | Piedmont Parts Co., Durham, NC | 2016 – 2018

- Ran weekly inventory reporting in SAP for a 4,500-SKU spare parts catalog.
- Flagged slow-movers and pushed quarterly clearance lists that recovered roughly \$310K in tied-up cash over two years.
- Built the cycle count calendar that replaced annual wall-to-walls; cut count-related overtime noticeably.
