- Co-led the sepsis bundle refresh, raising 3-hour bundle compliance to the high 80s after rolling out a new EHR order set.
- Serve as physician champion for the opioid stewardship committee, reviewing high-MME discharge scripts and coaching residents on alternatives.
- Cover nocturnist shifts twice a month, managing rapid responses and code blue events across 4 inpatient units.
