- Rebuilt the unit's evening program rotation, cutting end-of-day behavior incidents from roughly 4 per week down to 1

- Serve as the on-call point of contact for parent calls about homesickness, conflict, or medical concerns within the unit
- Co-led the 2024 staff training on trauma-informed care with the camp's mental health director

- Led 5- to 8-day backcountry trips for groups of 10 campers ages 13-15 through the Three Sisters Wilderness
- Completed pre-trip risk assessments, meal planning for 11 people, and gear shakedown before each departure
- Handled one evacuation for suspected appendicitis, coordinating with base camp and SAR; camper reached hospital in under 6 hours
- Trained four new trip leaders on Leave No Trace ethics, bear-bag protocol, and group dynamics on long trail days
- Wrote post-trip reports flagging two trail sections needing reroute due to washouts
