Lead Veterinary Technician | Cardinal Ridge Animal Hospital, Raleigh, NC

- Run anesthesia for 12 to 18 surgical patients per week including TPLOs, splenectomies, and dental extractions; zero anesthetic mortalities across 740+ procedures
- Built a new patient triage workflow with the medical director that cut average ER wait time from 38 minutes to under 15
- Train and mentor 6 assistants and 2 new CVTs, owning skills sign-offs for IV catheters, blood draws, and radiograph positioning
- Manage controlled drug logs and DEA biennial inventory; passed two unannounced state board inspections with no findings
- Lead daily rounds with the doctor team and own treatment sheet handoff between day and overnight shifts

- Triage roughly 40 to 60 ER patients per shift; first tech on blocked cats, GDVs, HBC trauma, and toxin ingestions
- Placed jugular and saphenous catheters, ran CRIs (fentanyl, lidocaine, ketamine), and monitored ventilator patients overnight
- Trained junior staff on lactate, blood gas, and PCV/TS interpretation during morning rounds
- Worked closely with criticalists to draft anesthesia plans for high-risk patients with cardiac and renal disease

- Restrained for exams, vaccines, and venipuncture across an average of 28 appointments per day
