2021 - Present

- Co-teach with lead teacher in a classroom of 24 students, 7 with IEPs covering reading, ADHD, and emotional regulation.
- Run daily small-group phonics rotations using Heggerty and Foundations; 18 of 22 students moved up at least one reading level on F&P benchmarks this year.
- Translate parent conferences and weekly newsletters into Spanish for roughly a third of families.
- Track behavior data on three students with BIPs and share weekly summaries with the school counselor.
- Cover the classroom up to 45 minutes when the lead teacher is pulled for IEP meetings.
